The Supplier Quality Management System is a company designed Global Standard to protect against threats to Food Safety, Product Quality, insure Regulatory & Environmental Compliance, and Ethical Conduct and Treatment of Employees. The System holds suppliers and manufacturers accountable to demonstrate continuous improvement in the production and packaging of products in the global markets served by Reynolds Consumer Products.

The system is described and measured according to a Scorecard with Key Performance Indicators used to facilitate ongoing measures in: Procedures & Certifications, Environmental & Safety, Service, and Process.

The intent of the Supplier Quality Management System is to add value to both Reynolds and our suppliers. The System is managed by way of audits to understand the current condition, follow-up visits to validate progress, and assistance with implementation. The Reynolds Global Supplier Team provides resources to our suppliers to assist in all aspects of developing and implementing Food Safety and Product Quality Plans, and product & process improvement. These methods enable us to provide on going assessments and support in a consistent manner to meet the Company's Product Safety, Product Quality and Business requirements. In addition, the process facilitates the selection, evaluation, and approval of suppliers.

The nature of being a Consumer Products business requires us to assure the protection of our customer, the consumers who use our products, and the compliance to all applicable regulations.

All manufacturing shall meet and exceed all of the criteria stated:

- FDA compliance
- EC (European Commission) Directive 2007/19/EC
- Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) compliance
- CONEG compliance
- The European Packaging Regulations 94/62/EC
- California Proposition 65 compliance
- Ozone Depleting Substance compliance
- Latex free

We have zero tolerance for non-compliance to these requirements. Through our product testing, product & systems auditing, or otherwise, if we become aware of any evidence of a supplier's non-compliance, it will result in the termination of our relationship with the supplier.
